More than half the boys and girls tested in the healthy/underweight category range. The boys tested 20.4 % in the overweight category and 23.7% in the obese category. The girls showed approximately 14.3% in the overweight range and 15.4% in the obese category.

It was noted that there is an increase in the boys overweight category and a slight increase in the obese category. The girls decreased in the overweight range and the obese category.
