

## **Antisemitism/TITLE VI INFORMATION**

Flippin Public Schools defines Antisemitism as “a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities. Antisemitism may be expressed in speech; writing; visual forms; and actions, and employs sinister stereotypes and negative character traits.”

Discrimination and harassment based on antisemitism is expressly prohibited in the Flippin School District. The District strongly prohibits this behavior in both educational programs and activities. Students, parents or employees of the district who are experiencing these actions may report them directly to the Title VI Coordinator.
